The Aquilion One Genesis 320 Slice CT Scanner offers a full 360 rotation, which allows visualization of an entire organ in one volume scan. It also has a 78 cm patient opening and a 690lb patient weight capacity. Utilizing this advanced technology allows our registered CT staff to provide improved low dose lung cancer screenings, cardiac CT scanning, improved image quality, quicker scan times, and enhances the overall patient experience.

### Aquilion PRIME 80 Slice CT Scanner (Currently not installed, will be summer 2024)

Our Aquilion PRIME 80 Slice CT Scanner has a patient weight capacity of 660lbs. It allows advanced visualization of body structures in an incredibly rapid manner. The speed of this scanner allows our staff to capture diagnostic images of organ structures that slower scanners are not able to visualize very well. This scanner will have a fluoroscopy option that will enable our radiologists a realtime live view to better target lesions for biopsy, resulting in a better patient experience.

#### Vantage Fortian 1.5T MRI Machine

The Vantage Fortian 1.5T MRI Machine has a 71 cm patient opening, offers quiet and efficient scanning technology, and has a patient weight capacity of 550lb. It allows our registered and certified MRI staff to perform neuro, breast, musculoskeletal, vascular, cardiac, prostate, and body imaging with astonishing detail and accuracy. The MRI team is composed of specially trained technologists and two board certified Magnetic Resonance Safety Officers to assure best safety practices!

#### C-Arms

The TriState Imaging Center has top of the line C-Arms that offer substantial improvement in diagnostic accuracy. Our C-Arm machines convert x-ray technology into real-time images, enabling surgeons to make surgical decisions in the moment.

#### **Diagnostic X-ray**

Whether it is a routine chest x-ray, a gastrointestinal exam, or a PICC line placement, we can meet your needs! Our registered technologists, radiologists, and specialist radiology nurse are here to provide the care you need.

#### 3D Mammography, DEXA and Stereotactic Biopsy

Our 3D Tomosynthesis Digital Mammography machine is the most advanced technology available for the detection of breast cancer. Using 3D technology makes it easier for providers to detect breast cancer early and see the cancer size better than a regular mammogram. Our DEXA unit can determine bone density for patients who may be susceptible to osteoporosis. We also offer stereotactic breast biopsy if needed. Our mammography team are all certified and specialty trained in breast health.

#### Ultrasound

Although ultrasound is most company associated with pregnancies, it is also used to obtain images of the heart, abdominal and pelvic organs, and vascular (blood) systems throughout the body. Ultrasound is also used to perform image-guided procedures such as fine needle aspirations and thoracentesis, both therapeutically and diagnostically. Specially trained and certified ultra-sonographers staff the TriState Imaging Center and provide services on call, as needed.

It is done while you are under anesthesia and typically takes less than an hour and requires overnight stay.

#### **Common Sleep Disorders**

Sleep disorders that affect the quality of sleep can lead to serious chronic health issues, such as diabetes, hypertension, congestive heart failure, irregular heart rhythm, clinical depression, and stroke. - **Primary Snoring:** Harmless, but can cause small interruptions throughout the night that prevent deep sleep.

#### What We Offer

- **Diagnostic Polysomnogram (PSG):** General overnight monitoring and evaluation without treatment.
- Continuous Positive Airway Pressure (CPAP) Titration Study: If sleep apnea is diagnosed during a recent PSG, the patient returns to our Sleep Lab to determine an adequate CPAP pressure setting to open the airway and control sleep apnea.
- **Split Night PSG:** When moderate, or severe sleep apnea has been discovered in the first part of the sleep study, the second part is used for treatment of the disorder using CPAP.
- Multiple Sleep Latency Test (MSLT): A method used to diagnose narcolepsy and measure the degree of daytime sleepiness. To ensure accurate results, it is performed the morning following a Diagnostic PSG and a two-week recording of a sleep diary.
- Home Sleep Study: A home sleep study may be ordered if there is a strong suspicion of OSA. Home studies are not suitable for patients with significant co-morbid medical conditions that may degrade the accuracy of the test (conditions may include pulmonary disease, neuromuscular disease, congestive heart failure, and oxygen therapy).

#### Admission

Patients must be referred to TriState Sleep Lab by their primary care provider and must be four years of age or older.


